Available Lodging

Area 1	Cabins - (approx 8-10 persons per cabin). The cabins have no heat and most have windows that will need to be covered to keep out wind. 3 cabins have winterized windows but still have no source of heat.
Area 2	Gymnasium - (100 people total) Mattresses available but cots are recommended. These arrangements will be a little noisy but warm.
Area 3	Main Lodge 1st Floor (Assembly/Service Area) (20-30 allowed) Pros-Warm & cozy Cons - no privacy but a little quieter than the gym. Beds will need to be picked up early and put down late to accommodate other Camp activities.
Area 4	Women's Area - A specially designated facility serves as quarters for women. Female staff and leaders will be required to room here or off campus. Be sure and specify if you will need arrangements for your ladies.

All lodging reservation requests will be received and assigned on a first-come first-serve basis. Please make your request in order of preference. As soon as the MYD office receives your lodging request an email confirmation will be sent to you informing you of the lodging arrangements your outpost has been granted.
